Most of our regular May board meeting was taken up with discussing our 18-19 budget which was presented at the Annual meeting on the 20th. We are taking another of our "leaps of faith" that our congregation tends to do every few years. We are very fortunate to have a healthy reserve balance that will carry us through about 5 more years of deficit spending. By the end of those 5 years, we plan to have grown our membership and our pledges to the point that each year will have a balanced budget, and we will begin to replenish our reserves. We are confident that, with Rev. Rita's capable leadership and outstanding ministry, and the continuing efforts of our congregation, this plan will become a wonderful reality.

Tony Filipovitch will be our delegate to the UU General Assembly this June. He is attending especially to be able to be there as Rev. Rita walks in with all the newly-ordained UU ministers!
