The Re-opening Task Force has the wisdom of UUA and MidAmerica resources, as well as plans to reopen in stages from congregations which have already begun strategizing.

Soon, we will all be together again. In the meantime, enjoy the freedom of movement that you have, be mindful of those whose restrictions are not yet lifted, and cultivate patience in yourself and those you love.
